Building Owners and Managers: Use this checklist to ensure your buildings meet local, city, and state laws with strict energy and emissions regulations. Maintain a Master Building Inventory

Track each building's square footage, use type, and applicable jurisdictional requirements.

Benchmark Building Performance

Centralize Utility and Fuel Data

Collect, organize, and validate energy and fuel data monthly to support accurate reporting.

Track Emissions Performance

Calculate emissions from electricity and thermal fuels and monitor year-over-year trends.

Align Capital Planning to Compliance Timelines

Build a 3–5-year capital improvement plan tied to jurisdiction-specific regulatory deadlines.

Identify Available Incentives Early

Evaluate federal, state, local, and utility incentives before funding windows close.

Establish Internal Stakeholder Governance

Coordinate finance, operations, sustainability, and engineering teams.

Model Long-Term Compliance Pathways

Assess future scenarios to prioritize investments and reduce reactive decision-making.
